

## **Mosaico di pace**

### **Basic principles**

Mosaico di Pace (Mosaic of Peace) is born, addresses and endorses active and evangelical nonviolence. Its priorities are to give voice and space to even small realities that are in this perspective, which put in place practices of peace, disarmament and justice, which are witnesses of commitment and solidarity towards poors, migrants and weaker categories.

It is a magazine inspired by secularism as a basic value, pluralism and multiculturalism, the encounter between faiths and religions, the nonviolent dialogue between cultures.

Editors and collaborators fully share these premises, they are an expression of realities and institutions which build up policies of peace and justice. They are volunteers, experts in specific thematic areas, but at the same time they are travel friends. The network that the magazine creates is virtual but also human, it is transversal because it gives voice not only to experts but also to witnesses or persons who, as mentioned, practice and believe in nonviolence. Inspirers are all those who, in the history, have built this nonviolent proposal: from Jesus to Gandhi, from Martin Luther King to Bonhoeffer ...

Principles of equality, solidarity, hospitality, inclusion, freedom of expression are inalienable.

### **Protection of people's dignity and respect for diversity**

Mosaico di Pace is committed to complying, in various communications, in articles and in a general perspective, with the respect for people and gender diversity, by promoting appropriate, plural, dutiful languages that do not harm people in any way, their image and the dignity of each.

It is also committed to taking care of relationships by giving priority, in daily work, to communications with readers, telephone or e-mail or via social networks replies. Readers and sympathizers of the magazine are persons with whom to enter the network and in relationship, and not numbers to manage.

The editorial team is committed to offering, alongside information and insights, a periodic creation of physical or virtual "places", for comparison and expression of ideas, even if different from their own, always respecting the principles of democracy and those contained in the Italian Constitution. There will be no expression of racism, discrimination, fascism, violence and incitement to crime and, if these conditions are met, they will be reported to the guarantor for privacy, postal police or judicial authorities.

Respect for diversity is encouraged by accompanying users to solving their problems, within the limits of available resources and possibilities: telephone help for the elderly to access web services,

creation of podcasts for the blind, reduced costs for "not guaranteed" categories (retired, unemployed, young people), free access to the magazine for poor or schools....

Local information, grassroots movements, groups and associations, minority ethnic groups, marginalities of any kind are also promoted. A preference and a priority of information of this kind is therefore guaranteed, by offering a space for minorities and local organizations which in their daily actions build up a disarmed world, spread or practice nonviolence, respect the environment and promote its protection, take care of poor, migrants and all those living in the suburbs.

The editorial team gives priority to sources that are directly informed of events, phenomena, and problems that are discussed.

Unverified news will not be published.

Childhood is protected in every way and form.

Women and their rights, equality and freedom of expression are also protected.

Mother Earth is protected and a culture of respect for life in all its forms is promoted.

### **Privacy and personal data management**

Mosaico di pace adopts all appropriate security measures to guarantee the privacy of readers and users, and the correct destination and use of personal data. All necessary measures are operational to safeguard the conservation, confidentiality, integrity, completeness, availability of personal data of the interested party, in compliance with the current legislation on the matter, in order to ensure a correct use of sensitive and personal data, and to avoid improper and unauthorized use of them. In particular, the editorial team guarantees the compliance with the new privacy provisions, which entered into force on 25 May 2018, the so-called *General data protection regulation*, and declares to comply with the rules contained therein.

The cyber security of the site is also guaranteed by protecting the owner and other users from potential cyber attacks.

Data collected through the site are used only for the purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the site and to check its correct functioning, and are deleted immediately after processing.

Data could be used to ascertain responsibilities in case of hypothetical computer crimes against the site.

Personal data collected during navigation are processed by automated tools and not on informatic support. The treatment is carried out by internal staff.

The editorial staff is committed to managing commercial requests duly and seriously, to responding promptly to information requests received through contact forms or other communication channels, and to promoting a real transparent, linear and efficient communication network with readers and supporters.

Promotional activities are also carried out in compliance with the current legislation and without abusing readers' tolerance, by making non-invasive and non-continuous promotion. Any request for suspension of advertising, messaging, various information will be answered punctually.
